



8 Days Beijing Xian Shanghai Join-in Tour

As one of the top selling China tours, this 8 days all inclusive China tour package is a smart choice as it covers the must see highlights of Beijing, Xian and Shanghai such as the Great Wall of China, the Forbidden City, the Summer Palace and the Temple of Heaven in Beijing, the Terracotta Warriors Army in Xian as well as the most important sights in Shanghai.

D01 → Beijing

On arrival in Beijing, meet our guide and transfer to hotel. The rest of day is at leisure.

D02 Tiananmen Square Forbidden City Temple of Heaven Kung Fu Show Beijing Roast Duck Dinner (B+L+D)

Pick up from your hotel at 08:30 am. Visit to the world largest square-Tiananmen Square. Then move on to the largest Imperial Palace in the world-Forbidden City where 24 emperors of Ming & Qing dynasty lived and controlled China from there for several hundred years. After lunch, head to the Temple of Heaven which was built in 1420, once was the venue for the Ming and Qing emperors to offer sacrifices to Heaven and pray for good harvest for the coming new year. Pay a short visit to the Silk Centre and enjoy free shopping. Enjoy live Kung Fu Show after Beijing Roast Duck Dinner. Transfer back to your hotel at 2100pm.

D03 Great Wall at Badaling Ming Tomb Olympic Stadiums (B+L)

Pick up from your hotel and take a 2 hrs drive to Badaling Great Wall, the symbol of ancient Chinese civilization and the landmark of China. On the way, visit the jade factory where you can buy some souvenirs. After Chinese style lunch, visit the Changling Mausoleum, the largest of the 13 Ming Tombs. The 13 Ming Tombs are the cemeteries of the 13 Ming emperors after the Ming Dynasty moved the capital to Beijing. The next stop will be an exterior tour to the Olympic Stadiums-the "Bird Nest" and the "Water Cube". On the way back to your hotel, a 45 minutes' visit to the traditional Chinese Tea House where you can enjoy tea ceremony.

D04 Summer Palace Beijing → Xian (B+L)

Pick up from hotel and head to the Summer Palace. Built in 1750 and known as the existing largest, best-preserved imperial gardens of the world, the Summer Palace inscribed on the UNESCO's World Heritage List in 1998. After lunch, transfer to the airport and take a two-hour flight to Xian, the "Museum City". On arrival, meet our Xian guide and transfer to your hotel. Explore the city on your own.

D05 Terracotta Warriors Big Wild Goose Pagoda Shaanxi Provincial Museum (B+L)

Our sightseeing this morning features the Terracotta Warriors Army and Horses Museum. It is not only reputed as the world's Largest Military Museum but also the Eighth Wonder of the world. After typical Chinese lunch at local restaurant, visit the Shaanxi Provincial Museum which built after the model of Tang Dynasty and featured with a total of 113,000 relics unearthed locally. Tour will be finished with the Big Wild Goose Pagoda which was built by one of the Tang Dynasty emperors as an act of filial piety to honor his mother. Transfer back to your hotel in the late afternoon. You can take an optional tour of Tang Dynasty Show and Dumpling Banquet at only \$45 this evening.

D06 Bell & Drum Tower Square Ancient Cultural Street Xian → Shanghai (B+L)

Pick up from your hotel after breakfast. Stroll along the Bell & Drum Tower Square and Ancient Cultural Street. After typical Chinese lunch at local restaurant, transfer to airport and take 2 hrs flight for Shanghai, known as the "China's Star". On arrival, meet our Shanghai guide and transfer to hotel. Explore the city on your own.

D07 Jade Buddha Temple The Bund Yu Garden Former French Concession Area People's Square (B+L)

Our sightseeing this morning is the Jade Buddha Temple, which was built in 1882, is a well preserved Buddhist temple. Then pay a visit to the Ming era Yu Garden which is the most famous classical garden of Shanghai. After typical Chinese lunch, tour the more impressive Bund. Known as the symbol of Shanghai, the Bund featured with 52 high-rises of all styles stand in the west, showing the art of world architecture. Then visit the Old French Concession Area, the White House and Pudong New Shanghai-The People's Square. Transfer back to your hotel in the late afternoon. This evening you can take an optional charming coach tour of Night Shanghai at \$59.

D08 Departure → (B)

Pick up from your hotel after breakfast and transfer to the airport for departure. End of our memorable China tour.
